Summary

Manages and provides care for assigned caseload in consultation with healthcare team providers following approved clinical protocols.

Essential Functions

- Performs various types of examinations under the supervision of a physician
- Performs clinical evaluations; assess and diagnoses injury or illness as appropriate; plans, prescribes and implements follow up care utilizing established protocol
- Obtains and interprets patient information considering age specific needs
- Conducts patient education and provides patients with discharge instructions
- Reviews patient labs and test results and informs of results in a timely manner
- Assists in the triage of patient calls and clinical needs
- Initiates quality assurance activities, policy/procedures and research activities
- Serves as a consultant to staff, physicians and patients
- Provides formal and informal education to staff and identifies and implements ongoing staff development in area of specialty
- Understands the needs of patients, their families, physicians and co-workers and does what is required the first time, every time by being responsible, sensitive, accurate, timely, coordinated and thorough
- Conducts assessments, diagnoses skin conditions, prescribes medications, performs minor procedures, offers skincare advice, and manages chronic skin conditions, collaborating with dermatologists to provide comprehensive care and education.

Education/Experience

- The successful completion of an approved nurse practitioner program is required
- Current Pennsylvania RN license and CRNP certification are required
- Current CPR certification is required
- BSN, MSN is preferred
- Professional nursing experience and/or nurse practitioner experience is preferred

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Required to maintain absolute confidentiality of patient care, patient accounts and hospital related matters.
